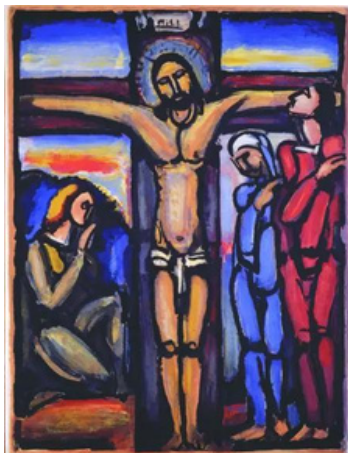
The Passion

News from St. John's, Burlington

Hello Bewsborough from St John's Anglican Church, Burlington.

It's hard to believe that we have been here for 8 weeks. In many ways the great send off at St Andrews and Shepherdswell Village Hall you all so generously organized seems just a few short days ago. Somehow the whirl of stepping into and new ministry just prior to Easter, finding a new home (rectories are largely a thing of the past in Canada), adjusting to life in a new country, learning new ways of doing things (driving on the right included) the time has passed in the blink of an eye.

We've been blessed in so many ways, the good people of St Johns have been incredibly welcoming, helpful and patient. It's been the mildest, driest winter on record (so all the thermal underwear and woolly hats have stayed in the 'closet', as we have to call cupboards now) and Burlington is a beautiful place to be, right on Lake Ontario. Added to that I'm afforded the impossible luxury of just one church to minister! When I tell my colleagues in the Niagara Diocese that I've just come from a 6-church parish, the reaction is somewhere between shock and admiration for Sean and all the Bewsborough ministry team. As you can imagine most of my parish activities include eating in one way or another (see the picture of me making pancakes on Shrove Tuesday, which are served with sausages and maple syrup here). I've also attached a picture of me presiding at my first service. St Johns church building is great, it dates from 1839 and is made entirely of wood from the ground up, so naturally we are all very careful with candles. I've also been getting into Canadian life with my first trip to a (Ice) Hockey match (Ontario Hockey League: Burlington Bulldogs vs Ottawa 67s, a 5 – 2 victory to the Bulldogs, hooray).
